## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPORTIONMENT OF THE COSTS OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK AMONG THE CITIES OF BOSTON, REVERE, CHELSEA AND THE TOWN OF WINTHROP.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the  
2 expenses of county government in the county of Suffolk,  
3 including the operation of county installations and the furnishing  
4 of county services such as the house of correction, the county  
5 jail, registry of deeds, the courts and medical examiners, shall be  
6 apportioned among the cities of Boston, Revere, Chelsea and the  
7 town of Winthrop.
