## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

### **AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXPENSES OF PROBATION OFFICERS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 276, section 94 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the first sentence and adding the  
3 following two sentences in its place:

4 The reasonable expenses, including supplies and equipment,  
5 incurred by the Probation Officers of the Superior Court in the  
6 performance of their duties shall be approved and apportioned  
7 by the Supervisor of Probation for said Court, and paid by the  
8 Commonwealth. The reasonable expenses, including supplies and  
9 equipment, incurred by the Probation Officers of the Probate  
10 Court in the performance of their duties shall be approved and  
11 apportioned by the Court, and paid by the County to which they  
12 are apportioned.
