**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE LOCAL HOUSING AUTHORITIES FOR BUDGET DEFICIENCIES ARISING FROM THE OPERATION OF STATE-AIDED LOW-RENT HOUSING PROJECTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 32 of chapter 121B of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the third sentence and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following sentence:—

4 Any deficiency in the budget of a housing authority caused by  
5 operation of state-aided low-rent housing projects shall be  
6 reimbursed by the Commonwealth and paid to the housing  
7 authority in an amount equal to the difference between the rents  
8 received from tenants in all such projects and the prorated cost  
9 of operating all such projects.
