The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE CLOSING OF CERTAIN PUBLIC SCHOOLS ON DAYS IN WHICH STATE OR NATIONAL ELECTIONS ARE HELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 64 the following section:—

3 *Section 64A.* Every school committee shall direct the closing
4 of all schools under its jurisdiction which are used as polling
5 places on the day that any state or national election is held.
