

HOUSE No. 3465

By Mr. Flaherty of Boston, petition of Michael F. Flaherty relative to increasing the salaries of assistant clerks in certain district courts, Counties.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO SALARIES OF ASSISTANT CLERKS IN CERTAIN DISTRICT COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 80, as most recently amended by section 2 of
3 chapter 668 of the acts of 1971, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following section: —

5 *Section 80.* In courts in which the salaries of clerks are
6 established by section seventy-nine, the salaries of first assistant
7 clerks shall be equal to eighty-seven and one-half per cent, and
8 the salaries of all other assistant clerks shall be equal to eighty
9 per cent, of the salary of the clerks of their respective courts.

The Amendments to the Constitution

As proposed by the Council of the State

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened, that the Constitution of the State of Mississippi be amended as follows:

1. Chapter 315 of the General Laws be hereby amended by striking out section 661 and the words "and section 662" of said chapter and the words "and section 663" of said chapter.
2. Section 661 in said chapter be amended to read as follows:
3. Section 662 in said chapter be amended to read as follows:
4. Section 663 in said chapter be amended to read as follows:
5. The words "and section 664" shall be added to the end of section 661 of said chapter.
6. The words "and section 665" shall be added to the end of section 662 of said chapter.
7. The words "and section 666" shall be added to the end of section 663 of said chapter.
