**AN ACT TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING THE TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS PURSUANT TO THE RACIAL IMBALANCE LAW DUE TO THE ENERGY CRISIS IF A PARENT SO REQUESTS**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Any racial imbalance plan in effect under the  
2 provisions of sections one I, one J, or one K of chapter fifteen of  
3 the General Laws and of sections thirty-seven C and thirty-  
4 seven D of chapter seventy-one of the General Laws which  
5 requires the busing of pupils beyond the nearest neighborhood  
6 school shall not apply to a child whose parents object in writing  
7 to the school which said child attends.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section one of this act shall  
2 become inoperative on July one, one thousand nine hundred and  
3 seventy-six.
