AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AMOUNT OF ANNUAL PENSION PAYABLE TO CERTAIN PERSONS UNDER THE ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY PROVISIONS OF THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (iii) of paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 7 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
3 section 1 of chapter 545 of the acts of 1951, is hereby further
4 amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in
5 place thereof the following sentence: — Such additional pension
6 on account of any such child shall be paid only so long as the
7 remainder of such allowance is being paid and only so long as
8 such child survives, remains unmarried and is under age eighteen
9 or if over said age remains physically or mentally incapacitated
10 from earning or if reaches said age eighteen and is a student then
11 only so long as attends a school of higher education.
