### **AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT IN CERTAIN PENSIONS, RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES AND ANNU- ITIES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of any general or special law to  
2 the contrary, every retired person, widow or other beneficiary  
3 receiving a pension, annuity or retirement allowance from the  
4 commonwealth or its political subdivisions shall be entitled to an  
5 annual cost-of-living increase in such pension, annuity or retire-  
6 ment allowance computed on the same basis as allowed to  
7 employees of the commonwealth or any of its political subdivi-  
8 sions.
