RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO LOW AND MODERATE INCOME PUBLIC HOUSING AND OTHER MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-
3 tives, and three persons to be appointed by the governor, one of
4 whom shall be the secretary of the executive office of communi-
5 ties and development or his designee, one of whom shall be the
6 secretary of the executive office of educational affairs or his
7 designee, and one of whom shall be the secretary of the executive
8 office of consumer affairs or his designee, is hereby established
9 for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to
10 the feasibility of using money from the state employee's
11 retirement system, the teachers' retirement system, the county
12 and municipal retirement systems, and such private funds as are
13 regulated by the health, welfare and retirement funds board as
14 mortgage capital for the construction of low and moderate
15 income public housing and for student loans and such other
16 public purposes as may be designated by the commission.
