AN ACT PROTECTING INDIVIDUALS AGAINST DISCRIMINATION BECAUSE OF MARITAL STATUS IN FURNISHING CREDIT AND SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 151B of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 325 of the acts of 1973, is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following clause: —

4 (15) For any person furnishing credit or services to require
5 information as to the marital status of the person seeking such

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PRINTING OF REPORTS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND FOR THE PRINTING OF REPORTS OR OTHER DOCUMENTS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress assembled, and by the approval of the President of the United States.

- 1 Section 1 of Chapter 1111 of the Statutes at Large, as amended by Chapter 1111 of the Statutes at Large, is hereby amended by adding the following clause:
- 2 " (1) For separate printing, there shall be provided for the printing of the reports and other documents of the House of Representatives and for the printing of reports or other documents of the House of Representatives."
