By Mr. Rourke of Lowell, petition of Raymond F. Rourke for legislation to prohibit a crushed motor vehicle from being conveyed over a public way unless it is secured in an enclosed truck. Public Safety.

AN ACT PROHIBITING A CRUSHED MOTOR VEHICLE FROM BEING CONVEYED OVER A PUBLIC WAY UNLESS IT IS SECURED IN AN ENCLOSED TRUCK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 19 the following section: —

3 *Section 19A.* Whoever causes a crushed motor vehicle to be
4 conveyed over a public way unless it is properly secured in an
5 enclosed truck shall be punished by a fine of not more than five
6 hundred dollars.
