## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE AMOUNT OF PENSIONS PAYABLE TO WIDOWS AND CHILDREN OF DECEASED PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 102 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out paragraph (b), as appearing in section 7  
3 of chapter 793 of the acts of 1972, and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following paragraph: – (b) Such percentum of change shall,  
5 subject to the provisions of paragraph (c) of this section, be  
6 applied to the amount of the pension, retirement allowance or  
7 annuity, exclusive of any amount of additional annuity obtained  
8 by special purchase, as provided under paragraph (g) of subdi-  
9 vision (1) of section twenty two, payable to any such former  
10 employee, widow or other beneficiary under any general or  
11 special law as fixed on December thirty first nineteen hundred  
12 and sixty nine, or to the original amount of any such pension,  
13 retirement allowance or annuity which became effective subse-  
14 quent to said date.
