AN ACT LOWERING THE AGE LIMIT REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause 17 of section 5 of chapter 59 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in the first
3 sentence the word "seventy" and inserting in place thereof the
4 following word: - "sixty-five".
