RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE PROCEDURES WHEREBY THE MASSACHUSETTS PORT AUTHORITY GRANTS CONCESSIONS AT THE GENERAL EDWARD LAWRENCE LOGAN AIRPORT.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-
3 tives and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study of the procedure whereby the Massachusetts Port
6 Authority grants concessions at the General Edward Lawrence
7 Logan Airport, with particular emphasis upon improving such
8 procedure. Said commission may require the attendance and
9 testimony of witnesses under oath and production of books,
10 records and papers.

The Constitution of the State

Article I. The Legislative Department

Section 1. The legislative power shall be vested in the Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of twelve members, six of whom shall be chosen by the electors of each county, and six by the electors of the State at large.
