## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO TRANSFER SKATING RINKS AND SWIMMING POOLS TO CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to transfer all swimming pools and  
3 skating rinks to the cities and towns in which they are located.

1 SECTION 2. Said commission is hereby further authorized  
2 and directed to transfer any other property, both real and  
3 personal to the department of natural resources.
