

of any such person shall not, in an action for slander or for publishing a libel, be held liable in damages for or on account of any defamatory matter uttered, broadcast, telecast or published over the radio or television facilities of any such station or network by any person whose utterance, broadcast, telecast or publication is not, under the provisions of any law of the United States or any regulation, ruling or order of the Federal Communications Commission, subject to censorship or control by such station or network.

AN ACT VALIDATING THE ACTION OF THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF MEDFIELD IN ADOPTING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATIVE TO PROVIDING INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR EMPLOYEES OF SAID TOWN. Chap.379

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The action of the voters of the town of Medfield taken at the annual town meeting held in said town on March fourth, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven in voting that chapter thirty-two B of the General Laws be accepted by said town is hereby confirmed and validated, notwithstanding the fact that warning of such vote was not given in the warrant for the meeting.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL BEACH FACILITIES AND IMPROVEMENTS AT THE WALDEN POND STATE RESERVATION. Chap.380

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of the county of Middlesex are hereby authorized to provide additional beach facilities and improvements at the Walden pond state reservation. For said purpose, said commissioners may expend out of any available funds the sum of fifty thousand dollars, which sum shall be included in the appropriations for the current year for said county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN FUNDS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO THE SECRETARY OF THE ARMY FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLETING THE IMPROVEMENT OF TOWN RIVER IN THE CITY OF QUINCY. Chap.381
