**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A BANK SHALL NOT CERTIFY A CHECK WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE DRAWER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 3-411 of chapter 106 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out subsection (2) and inserting in place thereof the following subsection:—

(2) unless otherwise agreed a bank has no obligation to certify a check and shall not do so without the approval of the drawer.
