In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INFORMATION REQUIRED TO BE PROVIDED ON NOMINATION PAPERS BY THE VOTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 53 of the General Laws as
2 most recently amended by chapter 512 of the Acts of 1971, is
3 hereby further amended by adding, after the first sentence, the
4 following sentence:—No further information shall be required of
5 any voter signing a nomination paper.
