AN ACT PERMITTING CERTAIN HOLDERS OF SUMMER SEASONAL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSES TO ALSO HOLD WINTER SEASONAL LICENSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter one  
2 hundred thirty-eight of the General Laws, or any other general or  
3 special law to the contrary, a holder of a summer seasonal  
4 alcoholic beverage license in the counties of Berkshire, Franklin,  
5 Hampden or Hampshire shall, upon request, be authorized to also  
6 hold a winter seasonal alcoholic beverage license.
