AN ACT PROHIBITING POWER COMPANIES FROM PASSING TO THE CONSUMER ANY AND ALL FUEL ADJUSTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary,
- 2 power companies shall not increase rates or in any way pass on to
- 3 the consumer increased cost to same for fuel use in the
- 4 production of power.
