

By Mr. Delahunt of Quincy, petition of William D. Delahunt relative to retirement allowances for certain state employees. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES FOR CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Option (c) of subdivision (2) of section 12 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
3 section 2 of chapter 600 of the acts of 1968, is hereby further
4 amended by adding the following paragraph:—

5 If the beneficiary of such retirement allowance predeceases the
6 member receiving a lesser retirement allowance under this option,
7 the member shall, if his loss is greater than fifteen thousand
8 dollars because of the selection of this option, receive the
9 amount he would have received had he originally selected option
10 (a) of this subdivision.
