The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL SERVICE TO PREPARE AN EXAMINATION BASED UPON A CERTAIN POLICE MANUAL FOR APPOINTMENTS AND PROMOTIONS IN CERTAIN POLICE FORCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The director of civil service is hereby authorized
2 and directed to prepare a competitive examination based upon "a
3 manual for the instruction of applicants for examinations for the
4 police services" to determine appointments and promotions in
5 such police forces of cities and towns as are within the official
6 service, in the detective force of the state department of public
7 safety, in the capitol police force and in the police force of the
8 metropolitan district commission.
