The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING DISTRIBUTION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF STATE FUNDS TO CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law, the
2 equalized valuation of the aggregate property of all cities and
3 towns subject to local taxation, as determined by the general
4 court for the years nineteen hundred and seventy-four and
5 nineteen hundred and seventy-five, shall continue and be in
6 effect for the years nineteen hundred and seventy-six and
7 nineteen hundred seventy-seven.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law, no
2 distribution or reimbursement will be made to any city or town
3 until the commissioner of corporations and taxation is assured
4 that the property tax in such city or town is based on a one
5 hundred per cent valuation.

1 SECTION 3. Section two of this act shall take effect on
2 January first, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
