**AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF FISHERIES AND GAME TO
SUBSIDIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FISHING TRAWLER.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 The department of fisheries and game is hereby authorized and
2 directed to subsidize the construction of a fishing trawler of such
3 a nature as to compete with fishing trawlers presently operated
4 and in use by the Russian fishing fleet. For such purpose said
5 department may expend such sums as may be appropriated
6 therefor.
