AN ACT REGULATING ADMISSION CHARGES BY THE PUBLIC FOR USE OF METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION SKATING RINKS AND SWIMMING POOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 41 and inserting in place thereof the following
3 section: —

4 *Section 41.* The commission may provide and maintain upon
5 reservations and boulevards under its care, suitable accommoda-
6 tions for bathing, ice skating and boating. No admission fee shall
7 be charged the general public for use of bathing and ice skating
8 facilities.

9 The metropolitan district commission is hereby prohibited
10 from charging parking fees at Nantasket beach reservation.
