By Mr. Early of Worcester, petition of Joseph D. Early that certain corporations be prohibited from soliciting and advertising to the public for business in competition with private taxpaying businesses. Commerce and Labor.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE SOLICITING AND ADVERTISING FOR BUSINESS TO THE PUBLIC BY CERTAIN CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 180 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 the following section: —

3 *Section 30.* No corporation organized under this chapter
4 shall solicit or advertise to the public for business in competition
5 with private taxpaying businesses.

6 A violation of this section shall cause the revocation of all
7 licenses issued by any agency of the commonwealth or any
8 political subdivision.
