

ACTS, 1980. - Chaps. 157, 158, 159.

Chap. 157. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WEBSTER TO GRANT AN ALL ALCOHOLIC PACKAGE STORE LICENSE TO JFK CORP.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding any limitation on the number of licenses to be under the provisions of section seventeen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, but subject, however, to all other provisions of said chapter, the licensing authority in the town of Webster is hereby authorized to issue to JFK Corp. an annual license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

Chap. 158. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF EAST BOSTON TO ADJUST HIS BOOKS ON ACCOUNT OF MONEY STOLEN FROM HIS OFFICE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The clerk of the East Boston district court is hereby authorized to adjust his accounts by deducting from his cashbook receipts of money due to the county of Suffolk the sum of three hundred and nineteen dollars, which was the sum stolen from said court and not recovered in a burglary during the day of March thirty-first, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine and any restitution thereof is to be made directly to the treasury of the city of Boston.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the city council and mayor of the city of Boston.

Chap. 159. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NAHANT TO OBTAIN EASEMENTS NECESSARY TO CONVEY ITS WASTE WATERS TO A WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT IN THE CITY OF LYNN.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Nahant, by its board of selectmen, for the purpose of conveying its waste waters to the city of Lynn's proposed waste water treatment plant for treatment and disposal and for the purpose of insuring the purity of said town's ocean waters, is hereby authorized, subject to the written approval of the metropolitan district commission and the city of Lynn to take by eminent domain under chapter seventy-nine of
