AN ACT TO REMOVE THE TAX EXEMPTIONS OF CERTAIN TAX EXEMPT PROPERTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause Second of section 5 of chapter 59 of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter
3 412 of the acts of 1958, is hereby further amended by adding the
4 following sentence:—

5 Real property of the Massachusetts Port Authority and the
6 Massachusetts Turnpike Authority, and all state colleges and
7 dormitories thereof within the city of Boston shall not be subject
8 to the exemption provided by this clause.

1 SECTION 2. Clause Third of said section 5 of said chapter 59,
2 as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 219 of the acts
3 of 1970, is hereby further amended by adding the following
4 paragraph:—

5 (e) Real property of private educational institutions and
6 dormitories thereof located within the city of Boston shall not be
7 exempt under this clause.
