AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE PODUNK PIKE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of the general or
2 special laws to the contrary the department of public works shall
3 continue Podunk Pike from its present junction at Routes
4 forty-nine and nine in Spencer to connect to Route thirty-one
5 north of the town of Spencer, then in a northerly direction to
6 Route sixty-eight in the North Rutland, Hubbardston area, then
7 further northward through the Gardner area to the New
8 Hampshire border.
