AN ACT REGULATING THE LOCATION OF CERTAIN OIL AND GAS STORAGE FACILITIES AT COMMERCIAL AIRPORTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 35D the following section:—  
3 *Section 35E.* No person shall construct a storage facility  
4 having a capacity of more than twenty thousand gallons for  
5 inflammable substances within five thousand feet of the end or  
6 within one thousand feet of the side of any runway at a  
7 commercial airport and no runway shall be constructed within  
8 said distances from an existing storage facility of such type and  
9 capacity.
