AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE EVALUATION OF A PRESCHOOL-AGE CHILD FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The fourth paragraph of section 3 of chapter 71B of the
2 General Laws, inserted by section 11 of chapter 766 of the acts
3 of 1972, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence: —
4 Preschool-age children may also be referred for evaluation
5 regardless of whether they are enrolled in a regular education
6 program.
