AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR  
RELATIVE TO OBSERVING NOVEMBER TWENTY-SECOND OF EACH  
YEAR IN MEMORY OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting  
2 after section 12X, inserted by chapter 46 of the acts of 1960, the  
3 following section: —

4 *Section 12Y.* The governor shall annually issue a proclama-  
5 tion calling for a proper observance of November twenty-second,  
6 the anniversary of the death of President John F. Kennedy, the  
7 thirty-fifth President of the United States, in lasting recognition  
8 of the outstanding public service he performed for the United  
9 States and this commonwealth.

By the House of Representatives, passed August 1, 1917.  
The Senate passed the bill August 1, 1917.  
The President signed the bill August 1, 1917.
