

By Mr. Buell of Boxford, petition of Robert C. Buell and others (by vote of the town) that the town of Boxford be authorized to issue an all alcoholic beverage license to Far Corner Farm Golf Course, Inc. Government Regulations. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BOXFORD TO ISSUE AN ALL ALCOHOLIC LICENSE TO FAR CORNER FARM GOLF COURSE, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provisions of
2 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws, the
3 local licensing authority of the town of Boxford, as defined in
4 section one of said chapter one hundred and thirty-eight, is
5 hereby authorized to issue to Far Corner Golf Course, Inc., a
6 corporation duly established by law in the Commonwealth and
7 located in said town, a license to sell, during the year nineteen
8 hundred and seventy-four, all alcoholic beverages to be consumed
9 on its premises to its members and guests introduced by such
10 members and to no others. Such license shall not be transferable,
11 but shall be subject to all other provisions of said chapter one
12 hundred and thirty-eight.

1 SECTION 2. The state secretary shall cause to be placed on
2 the official ballot used in the town of Boxford at each biennial
3 state election the following additional subdivision to the question
4 which he is required under the provisions of section eleven of
5 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General Laws to
6 place on the official ballot in all cities and towns at such
7 elections, to wit: —

8 F. Shall an annual, nontransferable license, be granted in the
9 town of Boxford for the sale therein of all alcoholic beverages by
10 Far Corner Golf Course, Inc. to its members and to guests
11 introduced by such members and to no others?

12 If a majority of the votes cast in said town in answer to said
13 subdivision F is in the affirmative, said town shall, irrespective of
14 the results of the votes in answer to subdivisions A, B, C, D and
15 E, be taken to authorize, for the two calendar years next
16 succeeding, the issuance of a license, for the sale in said town
17 all alcoholic beverages to be consumed on the premises of Far
18 Corner Farm Golf Course, Inc. Such license shall be subject,
19 however, to all other provisions of said chapter one hundred and
20 thirty-eight.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
