AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT SALES OF AVIATION FUELS BE SUBJECT TO THE SALES TAX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (j) of section 6 of said chapter 64H
2 of the General Laws, as inserted by section 1 of chapter 757 of
3 the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by striking out the words
4 “or in the operation of aircraft”.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on September first,
2 nineteen hundred and seventy-four.
