AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE COMMISSION TO GRANT SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE FOR SCHOOL ATHLETIC FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence under the definition of “Approved School
2 Project”, as amended by chapter 1018 of the acts of 1973, is
3 hereby further amended by inserting after the word “district”, in
4 line 6, the words: — , or of any school athletic facility which is
5 separate from existing schoolhouses in a city, town, county, or
6 regional school district.
