AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON CONTRACTS
AWARDED TO RESTAURANTS LOCATED ON STATE HIGHWAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The provisions of any general or special law to the contrary
- 2 notwithstanding, any restaurant awarded a contract to oper-
- 3 ate on a state highway is hereby required to purchase fish
- 4 products from Mass.-based firms.
