AN ACT PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS  
OF LAW RELATIVE TO SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 270 of the General Laws, as most recently amended  
2 by Chapter 465 of the acts of 1975, is hereby further amended  
3 by inserting after section 21 the following sections: —

4 *Section 22.* Any person found in violation of Section 21 shall  
5 be fined fifty dollars for each offense.

6 *Section 23.* Persons designated by the commissioner of  
7 public health, the board of fire prevention, and the MBTA,  
8 and policemen and other peace officers are authorized to  
9 enforce the penalty provision of Section 22.

10 *Section 24.* Any citizen who requests a violator of Section  
11 21 to cease from continuing said violation, may, in the event  
12 said request is not complied with make a citizens arrest.
