AN ACT REQUIRING SCHOOL BUS OPERATORS TO BE LICENSED BY THE  
REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Clause (4) of section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws
- 2 as most recently amended by chapter 925 of the acts of 1973,
- 3 is hereby further amended by striking out the words: —or
- 4 who is licensed under section nine of chapter one hundred and
- 5 fifty-nine A.
