*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The provisions of general or special laws or regulations to  
2 the contrary notwithstanding provisional clerk employees in  
3 state operated skating rinks through the commonwealth whose  
4 positions extend for a period of at least 8 months shall be  
5 granted permanent status and receive all benefits as such pro-  
6 vided under the law.
