

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE NORTH SHORE CHILDREN'S FRIEND SOCIETY TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE. *Chap. 27*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The North Shore Children's Friend Society, originally incorporated by chapter eighty-one of the acts of eighteen hundred and forty-one, may hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding three hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LEASING BY THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD OF SUITABLE HEADQUARTERS FOR VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS. *Chap. 28*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The city of New Bedford may, for the purpose of providing suitable headquarters for veterans' organizations under the provisions of section nine of chapter forty of the General Laws, annually appropriate not more than ten thousand five hundred dollars, notwithstanding the provisions of said section nine which limit the amount of money that may be appropriated for such purpose.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT MAKING A CORRECTIVE CHANGE IN THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE SUPPORT OF DEPENDENTS. *Chap. 29*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The third paragraph of section 8 of chapter 556 of the acts of 1954 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 8, the word "one" and inserting in place thereof the word: — five, — so as to read as follows: —

All petitions and matters incidental thereto in cases pending in a probate court upon the effective date of this act, and thereafter transferred to a district court, as provided by this section shall be received and entered upon the docket of said district court without the payment of the entry fee required by section two of chapter two hundred and sixty-two of the General Laws, as amended by section five of this act.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING TRINITY CHURCH IN THE CITY OF BOSTON TO HOLD ADDITIONAL REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE. *Chap. 30*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Trinity Church in the city of Boston, incorporated by chapter eighty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and thirty, is hereby authorized to take, hold and manage real
