AN ACT RELATING TO THE POWER OF FRANKLIN COUNTY TO CARRY OUT A FEDERALLY-FINANCED PROJECT FOR RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE COUNTY JAIL AND HOUSE OF CORRECTION IN THE TOWN OF GREENFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Franklin County  
2 are hereby authorized to expend such sums as may be pro-  
3 vided by the United States Department of Commerce Eco-  
4 nomic Development Agency, or any other federal agency for  
5 renovations and improvements to the County Jail and House  
6 of Correction in the town of Greenfield and to carry out such  
7 project, notwithstanding the provisions of section two of chap-  
8 ter seventy-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-  
9 five as amended.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
