AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ENGINEERING TO CONSTRUCT LATERAL SEWERS IN THE CITY OF MALDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 747 of the acts of 1970 as most recently amended
2 by chapter 238 of the acts of 1975 is hereby further amended
3 by adding after section 4 the following section:

4 Pursuant to the provisions of section one, the department
5 of environmental quality engineering through its division of
6 water pollution control, is hereby authorized and directed to
7 expend an amount not to exceed one million four hundred
8 thousand dollars for the construction of lateral sewers in
9 certain various locations in the city of Malden.
