In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-eight.

AN ACT FURTHER CLARIFYING THE EXPENDITURES OF FRANKLIN COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING THE RECREATIONAL, AGRICULTURAL AND INDUSTRIAL ADVANTAGES OF SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 660 of the acts of 1972 as amended by
- 2 chapter 672 of the acts of 1977 is hereby amended by insert-
- 3 ing after the second sentence: —
- 4 Said commissioners may also expend such sums as may be
- 5 allocated therefor to develop the industrial and commercial
- 6 resources of said county, including but not limited to all forms
- 7 of advertising, research activities, surveys, data collection and
- 8 analysis, site surveys, seminars, industrial and commercial
- 9 expositions and displays and assistance to regional city and
- 10 town commissions and agencies engaged on commercial and
- 11 industrial development and promotion.
