AN ACT FURTHER CLARIFYING THE EXPENDITURES OF HAMPSHIRE COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING THE RECREATIONAL, AGRICULTURAL AND INDUSTRIAL ADVANTAGES OF SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 588 of the acts of 1967 as amended by
2 chapter 673 of the acts of 1977 is hereby further amended by
3 inserting after the second sentence the following sentence: —
4 Said commissioners may also expend such sums as may be
5 allocated therefor to develop the industrial and commercial
6 resources of said county, including but not limited to all forms
7 of advertising, research activities, surveys, data collection and
8 analysis, site surveys, seminars, industrial and commercial
9 expositions and displays and assistance to regional city and
10 town commissions and agencies engaged in commercial and
11 industrial development and promotion.
