AN ACT REQUIRING A SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENT TO BE APPOINTED TO MEMBERSHIP TO THE COMMISSION FOR OCCUPATIONAL EDUCATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1F of chapter 15 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 4 of chapter 613 of the
3 acts of 1974, is hereby further amended by striking out the
4 eighth paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following
5 paragraph: —

6 There is hereby established the commission for occupational
7 education which shall consist of seventeen members, six to be
8 appointed by the board of higher education, and eleven to be
9 appointed by the board of education.

1 SECTION 2. The tenth paragraph of said section 1F of said
2 chapter 15 is hereby amended by adding at the end the fol-
3 lowing words: — ; and one shall be a secondary school student.

1 SECTION 3. The eleventh paragraph of said section 1F of
2 said chapter 15 is hereby amended by adding at the end the
3 following sentence: — Notwithstanding the foregoing, the
4 member who is a secondary school student shall serve until
5 he ceases to be a secondary school student.
