AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CERTIFICATION OF CERTAIN TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 38G of Chapter 71, as most recently amended by
- 2 inserting the following paragraph at the end thereof: —
- 3 Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, any
- 4 person who has received approval or certification from the
- 5 Board as a teacher or instructor in a Chapter 74 vocational
- 6 education program shall be eligible for employment by a
- 7 school committee as a teacher in a vocational education pro-
- 8 gram not reimbursable in whole or in part under Chapter 74,
- 9 provided that such vocational education program is similar
- 10 to a vocational education program formerly taught by such
- 11 person.
