AN ACT PROVIDING PARTIAL FUNDING OF CHAPTER 766 SO-CALLED THROUGH CHANGING THE FORMAT OF LOTTERY FUND DISTRIBUTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, Section 35 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws as
3 most recently amended by Chapter 185 of the Acts of 1977
4 shall be further amended to include language which would
5 require that five percent of all revenues received from the sale
6 of lottery tickets or shares, and all other monies credited or
7 transferred thereto from any other fund or source pursuant
8 to law shall be used solely to reimburse cities and towns for
9 expenses of "Chapter 766," so-called. Further that this five
10 percent will be allocated by cutting the operational and adver-
11 tising costs of the Lottery Commission.

1 SECTION 2. That any reimbursements to cities and towns
2 received as a result of this Act shall not be used to reduce
3 any other reimbursement from the General Fund.
