AN ACT EXEMPTING TOWNS OF UP TO FIVE THOUSAND PEOPLE FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE CHAPTER OF THE GENERAL LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The definition of "Ambulance" in section 1 of
2 chapter 111C of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1
3 of chapter 948 of the acts of 1973, is hereby amended by in-
4 serting after the word "owned" in line 3 the following: —
5 except that owned by a town of a population of under five
6 thousand people.

1 SECTION 2. The definition of "Person" in said section 1 of
2 said chapter 111C is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 word "subdivision" in line 1 the following: — except a town
4 of a population of under five thousand people.
