

SENATE No. 427

By Mr. Tully, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 427) of B. Joseph Tully for legislation to direct the Department of Public Health to make a certain determination of need relative to bio-medical applications of Lowell, Inc., and to authorize construction of an artificial kidney center in Lowell, Health Care.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO MAKE A CERTAIN DETERMINATION OF NEED RELATIVE TO BIO-MEDICAL APPLICATIONS OF LOWELL, INC., AND TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ARTIFICIAL KIDNEY CENTER IN LOWELL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 25C
2 of Chapter 111 of the General Laws or any other special or
3 general law, the Department of Public Health is hereby
4 authorized and directed to make an affirmative determination
5 of need as set forth in said Section 25C with reference to an
6 Application to establish a chronic dialysis service unit, sub-
7 mitted to the Department of Public Health (Project No.
8 8-4256) on August 29, 1975, by Bio-Medical Applications of
9 Lowell, Inc., 200 Clarendon Street, Boston, Massachusetts
10 02116, for the construction and operation of an eleven-station
11 outpatient chronic maintenance hemodialysis facility in Lowell,
12 to be known as the Merrimack Valley Artificial Kidney Cen-
13 ter, construction and operation to proceed in substantial con-
14 formity with the representations contained in said Application.
