AN ACT INCREASING THE TIME CERTAIN PRISONERS ARE REQUIRED
TO SERVE BEFORE BEING GIVEN PAROLE PERMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 133 of chapter 127 of the general laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 464 of the acts of 1971 is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the words "provided further" in
4 line 16 the words: — except for any prisoner convicted for
5 a violation of section 2, 13, 13B, 15, 15A, 15B, 16, 17, 18, or
6 18A of chapter 265, or convicted of the violation of the attempt
7 of such acts.
